Sporting games and activities will be available daily, as well as creative crafts, games, puzzles and the opportunity to relax and watch television with friends.

Children staying until 4:15 will be offered a drink and a snack and children staying until 5:00 or 5:30 will enjoy a sandwich with a choice of filling, crisps or a yogurt along with a sweet treat.
