1. Evaluation of CW during Autumn 2	<p>The Committee discussed the CW sessions from this half term</p> <p>Children spoke positively about the OTB sessions because they like seeing stories acted out.</p> <p>They also liked watching some of the Bible stories as animations on the big screen.</p> <p>Everyone is really enjoying the singing assemblies and would like this to carry on.</p> <p>Picture News feedback was positive and the children are enjoying giving out certificates to those who contribute well.</p>
