| 4. Worship | Some of the children mentioned how much they have enjoyed listening to some live music during Collective Worship. This has been played by a combination of children in the school and also Mrs G. One child said it would be nice to listen to instruments other than the piano and we then had a discussion about how not everyone plays an instrument. The children felt strongly that we want everyone to feel included in worship and so came up with the idea of creating a worship band opportunity next year. Through discussion, we thought there could be a 'Worship Band' club once a week where those children who want to can come together and play percussion instruments whilst practising a worship song.
