Spring '22	Notes	Actions
1. Prayer Journals	We discussed what book to use for the Prayer Journals and Mrs G helped print front covers so that children could explain to the classes how the journals should be used.	Each class to write prayers to add to their compilation in the Prayer Journals.
2. Evaluating CW	We all agreed it is important to talk to lots of different children from across the school to find out what they think of the CW sessions. Mrs G will carry on talking to children during 'Hot Chocolate with the Headteacher' to find out what they have learnt from CW and whether it made children make different choices during the rest of the week. 3. Planning for Collective Worship	Mrs G shared the theme for next half term's CW sessions and we discussed aspects which the children would like to be incorporated into the CW sessions: Worship <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Through actions - Faith - Prayer - Through art and sign language - Through words - Friendship with God - Singing and music - Showing love - Celebration - The Holy Spirit 	Mrs G to take the list of ideas and incorporate them into the plan for CW in the spring term.
4. School learning environment	All agreed that they like the Bible verses linked to the school values which are displayed on our School Vision board in the main corridor. We talked about whether we can do any more in our school environment to inspire each other to live out our school vision for the whole of the school day. We considered the fact that some children might have moments where they feel fed up or lonely when they are at school and we think it is important to remind them that God is always with them. The children would therefore like to make posters to go inside the toilet doors, up the school corridors etc.	The children asked Mrs G to find a Bible quote with a message like 'you are never alone'. They will then decorate the verse to create posters. Mrs G can then photocopy and laminate so that the children can display them throughout the school.
5. Prayer	We discussed how we can encourage each other to say different kinds of prayers.	Mrs G to organise different coloured pebbles/stones that can be used for this purpose and
