<p>1. Planning for Collective Worship</p>	<p>The children felt that the current organisation for each CW session was working well: Roots (Bible verses and stories) Branches (What is God teaching us?) Flowers (How can we use God's words to help us flourish?).</p> <p>Good points:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Bible is used in every CW session - CW has been taking place in person in the hall which everyone has enjoyed - Children are enjoying singing - Wool CREW have enjoyed planning the reflective starters for each CW session - 	<p>Wool CREW would like to plan their own 'take away challenge' to end each CW session and then Mrs G can revisit and reflect during Celebrations on Friday.</p>
<p>2. The school learning environment</p>	<p>We discussed how we can ensure our school learning environment is unique to our school and ensure everyone who visits us can see our school vision.</p> <p>Good points:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Children like the Big Question display boards in classrooms - Artwork linked to Bible verses has been displayed 	<p>Wool CREW would like to add Bible quotations linked to the school values to the School Vision display in the main corridor.</p> <p>Staff to plan more opportunities for reflective and spiritual artwork linked to Bible verses to be displayed around the school.</p>
<p>3. Living our school vision out within the community</p>	<p>We discussed ideas for how we can encourage children to remember the school values outside of school when they are out in the community.</p> <p>Ideas:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Posters to go in local shops - Banners outside the school for people to read when they go past - Values tokens which children can earn when going into some local shops 	<p>Mrs G to speak to local shops to see if a token scheme can be introduced.</p>
<p>4. Prayer</p>	<p>We discussed the role of prayer in the school day:</p> <p>Good points:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Classes say prayers before lunch and sometimes at the end of the day - Children enjoy saying their own 'arrow prayers' during CW - Children sometimes like staff members to lead prayers - Children enjoy using the colour changing candles to indicate when to begin prayer time 	<p>Explore whether Prayer Journals can be introduced to each class so that there are a selection to choose from.</p> <p>Wool CREW to draft a new school prayer and speak to representatives from all classes to agree a final version.</p>
