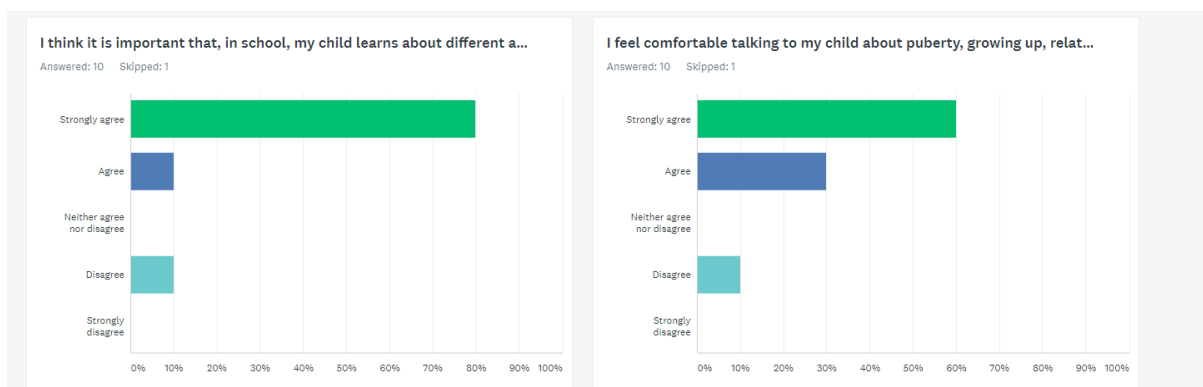
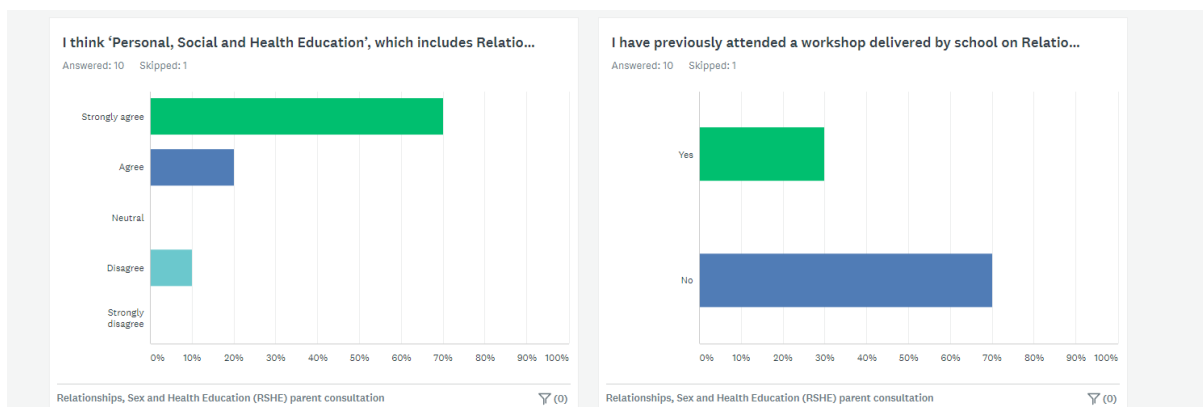


## RSHE PARENT CONSULTATION June 2021

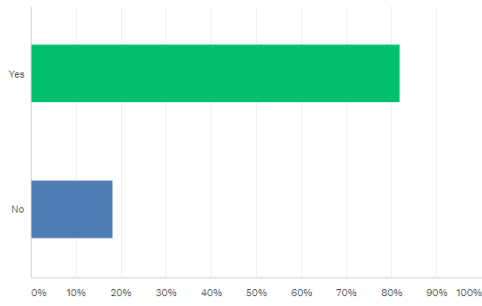

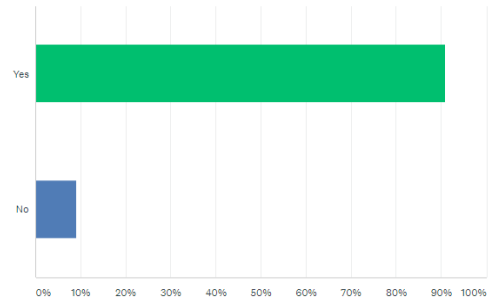

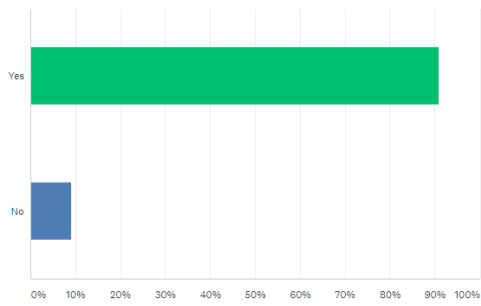
