It has been another busy and enjoyable week across our school. As we move towards the end of term, we are placing a strong emphasis on **online safety**. We know that children are increasingly using digital devices, and working together with families is key to helping them stay safe. We encourage you to:

- Have open and regular conversations with your child about how they use the internet, whether on a phone, tablet device or pc.
- Set up and regularly review parental controls on devices and apps
- Make use of information available on both school and other trusted websites about popular apps and platforms
- Check messages, contacts and activity where appropriate to ensure safe and positive use
- Consider the amount of screen time your child is having and ensure he/she has regular breaks where no digital device is being used at all

We are also pleased to invite parents and carers to attend an **E-Safety session** led by a member of the Neighbourhood Policing Team, taking place on **24th June (Lulworth site, 2.15pm)** or **25th June (Wool site, 9am)**. This will be a valuable opportunity to gain practical advice and ask questions about keeping children safe online.
